Wheel Try It

Fridays: March 1, 8, 15, 22 // April 5, 12, 19, 26 // May 3, 10, 17, 24, 31 | 1pm - 4pm | Kimball Staff

Friday afternoons the Kimball Clay Studio is open to anyone who wants to try their hand at clay. This is not a typical class. Instead, a studio staff member will provide a demonstration at the start of the session in either wheel throwing or hand-building techniques. A nominal \$15 fee includes enough clay for two completed pieces as well as firing and glazing. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. *Space is limited, reserve your spot early.*

Pendants in Clay

Saturday, March 9 | 3pm - 5pm | Nemo Miller

Create clay pendants for a necklace, bracelet, and a set of earrings. A \$60 fee includes instruction and all materials for one adult and one child.

Luck of the Irish Screen Printing

The leprechauns will be green with envy when they see your St. Patrick's Day t-shirt. Create your own custom design, then screen print and wear it! A \$60 fee includes instruction and all materials for one adult and one child.

Share drawing techniques and skills in a group setting while working with the model to communicate poses and complete timed sketches. This open-studio session is just \$15 per person. Students must bring their own drawing materials and must be at least 18 years of age.

If you're new to the Kimball, please check in with an education staff member at 10am for a quick introductory tour of the facility. This open studio session is just \$15 per person. Students must bring their own materials.

Abstract Painting

Tuesdays: March 5, 12, 19 | 10am - 12:30pm | Gabrielle Wolfe

Create expressively and connect with your intuitive side while discovering the joys of abstract painting. This class offers experienced painters a chance to reinvigorate their practice and is a perfect introduction for beginners. This three-week class is \$135 and includes materials.

Wheel Throwing

Tuesdays: March 5, 12, 19, 26 // April 2, 9, 16, 23 | 6pm - 9pm | Shasta Krueger

Join us for an in-depth exploration of clay on the potter's wheel. Students will learn clay preparation, wheel throwing, trimming, handle pulling, and the firing process while creating cups, mugs, bowls, plates and other forms. All skill levels welcome. The cost is \$450 and includes all eight sessions and one bag of clay. Additional clay is available for purchase.

Painting Exploration

Thursdays: March 7, 14, 21, 28 // April 4 | 10am - 12:30pm | Sophia Brown

Invest in your art while exploring brushes, mark making, layering, color mixing, and composition to develop your own voice in painting with oils and acrylics. This five-week class is \$225. A materials list will be sent out to students upon registration.

Glaze Chemistry

You won't want to glaze over this class! Students will learn about different materials used to create glazes, study their origin and experiment with various application techniques on forms created outside of class. Weekend Workshop: Animal Boxes in Clay with Visiting Artist Suzanne Fluty

Using basic hand-building techniques, students will learn how to simplify animal characteristics to create uniquely whimsical animal trinket boxes. Surface decoration using various slip applications and sgraffito will also be explored. This two-day workshop is \$200 and includes materials.

Let it Flow Watercolors

This full-day watercolor workshop focuses on drawing flowing lines and flowing colors, then painting vibrant flowers. The class is \$110 and covers materials, but not lunch.

Surface Exploration in Clay

This class will focus on the leatherhard to bonedry stages of clay and explore techniques including stamps, roulettes and sprigs, sgraffito, carving, mishima, water etching, and other slip applications. All levels welcome. This three-week course is \$185 and includes all materials.

Open Studio Evening

An event designed to satisfy "curiARTsity" and explore the creative process. A variety of media will be available and participants will be able to sign up for two classes. Demonstrations from teachers, all art materials, hors d'oeuvres, and personalized instruction are all included. This evening is \$40 per person.
