tots (ages 3 - 5)

At Kimball Art Center, we believe you are never too young to be exposed to art. Our camps help children develop their fine motor skills, build imagination, and experiment with various colors, textures, and patterns.

Camps are Monday-Friday unless otherwise noted. Class sizes are limited to provide the best experience and appropriate student to teacher ratio.

Watercolor Wonders // Painting

June 10 - 14 | 10:30am - 12pm | Maddie Michael | \$85

Explore the wonderful world of watercolor! The littles will learn about different watercolor techniques using wax resist, salt speckling, tape resist, and more. Your refrigerator will be decked out, as tots can take home a new masterpiece after each class.

Art from Around the World // Mixed Media

June 17 - 21 | 10:30am - 12pm | Karen Southam | \$85

Travel the globe to discover new and exciting ways to create art and learn about practices and artists from around the world. Campers will sculpt, paint, draw, make jewelry and more.

Under the Sea in 3D // Mixed Media

Tots explore sea creatures and make sculptures out of balsa wood, air-dry clay, metallic foil, and many more 3D materials.

Pottery Pets // Clay

teens (ages 13 - 17)

Teens will enjoy both individual and group instruction from teachers who aim to support creative art ideas and help improve technical skills. Camps are Monday-Friday unless otherwise noted. Some weeks, morning and afternoon camps can be combined for an all-day creative experience.

Please note, lunch and snacks are not provided.

Drawing a Likeness // Drawing

June 10 - 14 | 1pm - 4pm | Jordan Brun | \$175

Using graphite, colored pencils, and pastels, students will explore different styles of drawing and learn features, proportions, and values to create life-like portraits.

Wheel Throwing I // Clay

June 17 - 21 | 9am - 12pm | Kai Beckett | \$200

Learn the basics of the potter's wheel and make clay creations like cups, plates, and bowls. As students advance and build confidence, they can tackle additional wheel-thrown designs.

Digital Photography // Photography

June 17 - 21 | 1pm - 4pm | Jeffrey Scott | \$175

Learn about in-camera control, camera functions and settings, and discuss new techniques in this interactive class. Wear comfortable walking shoes as much of this class involves exploring nearby picturesque locations. Bring your own digital camera (no cell phone cameras).

Watercolor Wonderment // Painting

June 24 - 28 | 1pm - 4pm | Alex Moldavan | \$185

The painting journey begins with classroom learning and watercolor basics. Once mastered, students will take their drawing and watercolor skills outside to capture the beauty of Park City in watercolor.

Oil Pastels // Drawing

July 1 - 5 (no class July 4) | 9am - 12pm | Jordan Brun | \$185

After learning the fundamental oil pastel techniques, students will experiment with their own style and create a piece inspired by figures in action.

Figurative Sculpture // Clay

Capture yourself in clay! Students will learn to sculpt a full head portrait in clay while learning how facial structures and expression are related to the muscles and bones beneath. Beginners welcomed!

Graphic Design // Digital Art

Students will learn the fundamentals of graphic design including the design process, color theory, and typography before creating their own ski, skateboard, or snowboard design. Students will leave with a portfolio and a better understanding of how to design for themselves and clients. Bring your own laptop!

Sci-Fi & Fantasy // Painting

Create fantasy and science fiction inspired artwork using pencil, ink, and paint. Students will learn to take a drawing from concept to completion while learning about the practical use of sketching, references, and studies.

Magical Mosaics // Glass

This class covers glass and tile exploration. Students learn cutting, placing, grouting, and finishing skills to create a mosaic masterpiece. Self-portraits, pets, and abstract design are all exciting possibilities.

The Art of the Graphic Novel // Drawing

For students interested in creating a graphic novel, this class covers the practical aspects of crafting one. Story development, thumbnails, scene layout, dialogue, and drawing techniques are taught to make your story come to life.

S.T.E.M. education is better with art. We will integrate art projects into science, technology, engineering, and math to trigger creativity and make learning fun and memorable.

Robots // Mixed Media

Build, paint, draw, and more! Kids will explore ways to create whimsical robots using a variety of different mediums throughout the week.

Drawing Characters and Comics // Drawing

Campers will develop their own storyboards and characters to create a comic book. Anatomy, facial expressions, and different cartooning techniques will be covered.

Pretty Pastels // Drawing

Textiles: Knit, Felt, and Wearable Art // Mixed Media

This camp will introduce students to the basics of textile and fiber art techniques like embroidery, felt collages, knitting, weaving, sewing, macramé, tie dying, fabric painting, and more. Kids can wear their creations!

Learn about the many ways to paint your favorite things using watercolor, acrylic, palette knives, special techniques, and more!

Alpine Animals // Clay

Sculpt and glaze local animals such as moose, woodpeckers, and pika. Students will learn various handbuilding techniques in clay as well as the importance of local animals in our mountain ecosystem.

Watercolor Landscapes // Painting

Campers will learn watercolor basics, then take their new skills outside to draw and paint plants, flowers, and trees.

Artistic Animals // Drawing

Using color, shading, composition, and perspective, kids will learn to draw their favorite animals. Students can explore with pencils, markers, pastels, ink, charcoal, and graphite to bring their animal drawings to life.

Kids will learn a new technique each day to create bracelets, pendants, and rings using clay, wire, string, paper, metal, glass, beads, and other jewelry materials.

Each day campers will make a new project using the "material of the day." Expect paint, clay, collage, and other special materials.


